- Brookie Brotherhood (Schedule, Sleeping Arrangements, Service, Eating Arrangements)
 - Schedule Andrew, Alex, Dave, and Matt all worked to make the schedule.
 Mitchel asked for Akela correction in spelling.
 - Sleeping Arrangements Dave Zajac "As of right now, we can still sleep indoors, but numbers need to be reduced. I would recommend anyone that would like to sleep in a tent, SLEEP IN A TENT. Holds true for meals too. Depending on numbers, we might have to eat in shifts. We need to be open moving forward. All safely will stay in place. Event should still be a go, we just need to be open. • Elections (2021 Season, and Script)

- 2021 Season Andrew proposed that the season should be the same as the last three years (February 15 April 15). Opened Google Form January 1, 2021. Jeno moved to have election season February 15 April 15, with opening the Google Form on January 1, 2021. Second by Erik R. Andrew is not opposed to doing it before election season, but Andrew is opposed to do anything past April 15. If signed up and a lodge member cannot do election, election can still process past April 15. Mitchel asked why we do the 15 15. Mitchel moves to amend the motion on the table to start the Election season on February 1-April 1. Second by Danny K. Passed unanimously.
- Script We need to update the script to accommodate BSA Name changes, and pronoun changes to accommodate male and females.

Ceremonies

- Matt "We cannot use the term regalia. We have to use the term costumes."
- Need to consider updating scripts to include females. Mitchel looked into this.
 Scripts do not need to be changed.
- Need to consider building female costumes. Caleb said he will look into having Peter help us if we decide to build costumes.
- DJ "Peter and I looked into this already. We will help you out."
- Jeno "I don't know what the budget is, but it will be cheaper to build our own new costumes."
- Alex C. "For the time being, we could use our uniforms, instead of the costumes."
- Matt "Dining hall and Preston Center is where Dance and Drum, and Ceremonies can meet. Nothing in Rae's for safety. And social distance."
- DJ "technically our costumes are incorrect, so we will need to look into correcting these so they are rights for the area."
- Matt "National just made medallions for the purpose of ceremonies."
- Andrew looked into the price of medallions and the price is \$70.00 for the complete set. Staff advisor or Lodge Advisor has to order.

• Banquet Discussion

- Alex said that the drive in still has not gotten back to us on the date and time.
- The purpose of the Ad Hoc committee is to find and fit COVID regulations.
- Danny "If Pioneer drive in does not respond, there are other drive-ins in the area."
- Jeno suggested looking at other locations, but this cannot be possible because of COVID restrictions.
- Matt "Inside feasibility is not in the picture."
- o Dave "Buffett is out, again, due to COVID"
- Alex suggested that we maybe hold this outside maybe in the summer.

Lodge Service

- Alex C. "There was an idea to improve Lodge service around council and camps. We have trouble getting people to sign up for service. I have created a Google Doc to send out for better service opportunities and signing people up directly. They would be contacted directly rather than a guessing game.
 Furthermore, this is an opportunity to sign up your entire troop."
- Ranger Matt "Council is always looking for assistance. Merit badge days have been our recent activity. As the service arm of the council, we should be involved in council events."

State of the Lodge Address

- o Dave Z. idea
- Similar to the State of the Union Address by the POTUS
- Make a short video, 15 minutes max new leadership, events, service
- Dave "We have members who show up to an event and they don't know who the Key 3 of the Lodge is. Give us an opportunity to watch a video and see what the lodge did the previous year. A lot of people would be impressed if they actually knew. This would allow us to outline the upcoming year (service, leadership, events). This would give us a better chance to be better invested in the council and personally connect with Lodge members."
- Mitchel thinks this is a great idea and national does something similar.
- Jeno thinks this is a really good idea, especially if we can't do a banquet.
 Possibly include leadership section and national level.
- Alex C. "Definitely for this especially even sending a lodge newsletter in the beginning of the year."
- Danny K. "If we were to to did how would it be publicized"
- Dave Z. thinks to use it as Lodge master. Mitchel says a 15 minutes video is a large file to share. Alex C. - "We should do a countdown timer until the Address is to be presented."
- Mitchel "Agree with Alex's idea"
- Kevin S. "Sure believes this is doable. Hosting the file would be too large.
 Possibly put it on youtube on a closed channel (unlisted link)."
- Scott M. "we need to be careful with youtube algorithm picking up on a scouting relate video and having an inappropriate ad"
- Kevin "Maybe use a VIMEO."
