

# KUSKITANNEE LODGE #168 TRAINING TROUT AWARD

1. An Arrowman's primary duty is to his or her troop, therefore, credit will be given for conducting troop training. A minimum of 4 credits is required in this category but up to 10 can be obtained. 1 hour of training = 2 credits.

2. At every lodge event, some form of educational training is conducted. Lodge credits can be obtained for attending training at any lodge or section event. A minimum of 5 credits is required in the category and there is no limit. 1 hour of training = 1 credit.

3. **Conducting Credits:** active Arrowmen may be able to share their knowledge through training. There is no minimum but a maximum of 10 credits can be obtained.  
**National Credits:** special circumstances permit Arrowmen to attend national trainings. There is no minimum but a maximum of 10 credits can be obtained.
